

THE 22ND ADITYA BIRLA SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAMME

To commemorate the legacy of Mr. Aditya Vikram Birla's visionary leadership and continuing commitment towards supporting young generations of India through their educational journey, we are proud to present the 22nd batch of winning scholars. The Aditya Birla Scholarships programme, initiated in 1999, boasts a roster of 588 scholars, several of whom are highly placed with marquee companies, leading consultancies and universities globally. The scholarships are awarded to outstanding students in the Engineering, Management and Law streams. The top 20 students from each of these premier institutes – IITs, BITS Pilani, IIMs, XLRI Jamshedpur, FMS Delhi, NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad, National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, National Law University, Jodhpur, Gujarat National Law University and The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences, Kolkata, were evaluated. The process led to the shortlisting of 105 candidates from 336 students. Of these, 47 aspirants have been named "The Aditya Birla Scholars", by an eminent jury.


